

## Intelligent Buildings Council (IBC) Town Hall Notes

**April 27, 2017 in Santa Clara, CA**

(This was not a formal IBC meeting and therefore these are not official meeting minutes but rather meeting notes)

- Noah Goldstein (Navigant Research): Artificial Intelligence (AI) should be a session at the next CABA Forum event in 2018.
- Joe Briscoe (PLC Multipoint, Inc.): He suggested the MIT Media Lab could be the keynote speaker for the next IBC meeting.
- Jason Falbo (Mircom): Stated there needs to be an integrated design process for creating new buildings, this includes changes in the procurement methods.
- Peter Kallai (Canadian Printable Electronics Industry Association): The next IBC research and IBC meeting keynote speaker should be focused on “what do building owners want” and “how to end-users prioritize”.
- Scott McBrayne (Cadillac Fairview Corporation Limited): Asked what buildings and building models will be replicated.
- Noah Goldstein (Navigant Research): Talked about the idea of boring buildings and how people are overlooking technologies that are not “sexy” but are valuable.
- Marc Petock (Lynxspring Inc.): Talked about the importance of maximizing the life of a building.
- Jason Falbo (Mircom): Education and training for technicians is important and should be addressed.
- Debra Becker (Honeywell International Inc.): Debra who was the Chair of the IBC stepped down and introduced Trevor Nightingale (National Research Council) as the new IBC Chair. Trevor was currently serving as the IBC Vice Chair for the past few years.
